- Graduating Senior
- Enrolled in Shasta County 4-H for at least the past three years: sophomore, junior, and senior years.
- Complete the entire application process by the county due date, and attend a scholarship interview. ***Interviews will take place on Thursday, April 18, 2019. You must attend your scheduled interview to qualify; no exceptions. Please mark this on your calendar.***
- If awarded a scholarship, you must enroll at a recognized college, university or trade school within 12 months of the date of the award or all monies will be forfeited.

- _____ Attach a current photo of yourself to the application, (no larger than 4X6 inches).
- _____ Personal Story-you may use your Record Book “My 4-H Story” - 3-6 pages typed. Please sign and date.

- _____ Three (3) Letters of Recommendation from non-related person. Letters can be from a leader from an other club if necessary.
 - 1) Community Club Leader
 - 2) Project Leader
 - 3) Other- (school official, employer, church official, etc.)

Please note:

Applicants are responsible to verify that all parts of the application are received by the 4-H Office on or before the due date, including the three required letters of recommendation. Application may be mailed or hand delivered. If mailed please verify the application and letters of reference were received. It is the applicants responsibility to follow up with the persons writing the letters of recommendation and insure they are received by the 4-H Office. Letters of recommendation may be included with the application in a sealed envelope or mailed/delivered separately.

Incomplete applications will be disqualified. Late applications will not be accepted.
