


State 4-H Shooting Sport Match 2024

We were ready.











What is YQCA Training and why do we need to take it?

The Youth for the Quality Care of Animals training helps you take better care of your animal. All members - Showing or Selling an animal at Shasta District Fair or Inter-Mountain Fair in 2025 - are required by the State of California to complete this training.

<u>Training is available Online at your convenience</u>

The cost for online training is \$12 and you are provided with the certificate & unique identifying number that will be needed when registering for fair in 2025.

The cost for this training is \$3, but **you must register in the online program**, take
a test online afterward **and** let our office know when that has been completed.


